

# **Description**

PVC-free digital printing film based on a top-coated white polypropylene, glossy or matt surface.

# Release paper

One-side silicone coated paper, 135 g/m<sup>2</sup>

### Adhesive

Polyacrylate, permanent, transparent

For brilliant and colourful advertising efforts, for indoor and short-term outdoor use. Suitable for even and slightly curved surfaces. For outdoor applications the combination with ORAGUARD 236 laminating film is recommended.

### **Printing method**

Solvent-based inkjet printing, also suitable for UV and latex inks.

## Note

After printing the ink must be thoroughly dry in order to avoid any affect on the later combination with the laminate. Surfaces to which the material will be applied must be thoroughly cleaned from dust, grease or any contamination which could affect the adhesion of the material. Freshly lacquered or painted surfaces should be completely cured. The compatibility of selected lacquers and paints should be tested by the user, prior to the application of the material. Furthermore the application information published by ORAFOL is to be considered.
